## → Is it important to vote even though I don't know who these people are or what they do?

- ◆ For sure! As we learned in the AMUG 101 Guide, this is highly unlikely to be your only AMUG experience. It's important to share your voice in this group. Every full-conference attendee has a say in the growth of AMUG, from first timers to DINOs. You will be part of determining the future of AMUG!
- ◆ Voting takes place through the AMUG mobile app from Sunday, April 3 at 12:01am to Monday, April 4 11:59pm. Biographies for each candidate running for Board of Director positions will be available through the online planner and mobile app, and a brief video will be shown at the Monday morning general session. Feel free to talk to the candidates about their background and position they are running for. Ask others and become part of the process. You are a member of the AMUG organization and your vote is important.

## → What is the dress code?

- ◆ For the off-site evening event on Tuesday, we suggest that you wear closed-toe shoes and comfortable clothing appropriate for indoor and outdoor activities.

AMUG provides all transportation, sorry, for safety reasons, we do not allow you to drive or take alternative transportation. Locations in the past have included Universal Studio in Orlando, Museum of Science and Industry in Chicago, Gateway Motorsports Park in St. Louis, and so many more fun places.

## → Do I have to wear my badge at all times?

- ◆ Yes. Everyone must wear an AMUG badge to access the AMUG Conference, AMUGexpo, meeting rooms, and the Tuesday night off-site event (badges must be worn to get on the bus).
- ◆ Your badge includes a QR Code that will allow sponsors and exhibitors to scan and obtain your contact details that you registered with, however allowing a company to scan your badge is your call. Once the company scans your badge they will be able to contact you directly. AMUG follows strict GDPR rules and does not provide your contact information directly to sponsors, exhibitors or other members. AMUG does not sell the registration list to anyone. Please avoid companies that offer to sell you a registration list.
